Omaha Catholic School Consortium



Catholic Identity

St. Bernadette School incorporates a strong Catholic identity in all aspects of the school day. Students in kindergarten through eighth grade participate in Mass twice a week. Our students also share in the preparation and service of the Mass. A complete religion curriculum is in place to support and assist staff members including weekly mini-lessons from our school's pastor. Students are given opportunities to participate in school service projects sponsored by our Home & School Association, student council and through individual class projects inspired by generous hearts.

Academic Excellence

A Christ-centered academic curriculum features fine arts, technology, physical education and language programs that challenge students with a student-professional staff ratio of 16 to 1. St. Bernadette School is accredited by the State of Nebraska, AdvancEd Accredited, and also meets archdiocesan educational standards that exceed state and national requirements. Our students consistently perform in the top 25 percent of the nation for core subjects like math, language arts, reading, social studies and science.



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Curriculum

St. Bernadette School uses the Omaha Archdiocesan standards-based curriculum to drive and focus our instruction as well as the School Improvement Plan. Our academic curriculum includes religion, reading, language arts, handwriting, phonics, spelling, math, social studies, science, physical education, health, technology, art and library.

- **Junior High Electives**

Students in grades six through eight have the opportunity to participate in electives that include choir, spring musical, economics, study skills, vocabulary, current events and Fit for Life.

- **Spanish**

Spanish is provided as a class for all PreK – eighth grade students.

- **Pre-Kindergarten Program**

We offer an all-day preschool program using a curriculum that focuses on the developmental milestones of 3-to 5-year-olds. Students learn basic life, social and academic skills to prepare them for kindergarten.

Technology in the Classroom

St. Bernadette is a blended learning community, which means we combine traditional classroom instruction with computer-mediated activities. Technology is used to transform and improve the learning process for our students. Blended learning helps us reach and teach students more effectively using 21st-century technology. It provides our educators with an opportunity to collect data to help customize instruction and assessment of students based on individual needs. Our students have access to Chrome Books, iPads, computers, smart boards and more to help guide the learning process.

Extracurricular Activities

Whether your child is interested in academic clubs, programs to express creativity, or sports, St. Bernadette offers a wide variety of extracurricular programs to enhance student learning including: Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Book Bowl, student council, altar serving, book club and more. Students can also participate on the St. Bernadette Tigers' winning athletic teams in basketball, baseball and volleyball, and have the opportunity to participate in the Gross Junior Cougars programs including robotics, band, cheerleading, dance team, softball, wrestling and football.
