AFFORDABLE TUITION

At the Omaha Catholic School Consortium, we strive to make tuition affordable and to make Catholic education available to all children. We provide every family the financial ability to choose a Catholic education for their children through tuition assistance programs and payment plans. 2017-2018 TUITION RATES AND FEES

A non-refundable registration fee of \$100 is charged per student annually. A minimum \$100 of the total registration fee per family is due at the time of registration.* The remaining registration fee balance is rolled into the tuition payment. Below are tuition rates for the 2017 – 2018 school year.
