Academic Excellence

A Christ-centered academic curriculum features fine arts, technology, physical education and language programs that challenge students with a student-professional staff ratio of 13 to 1. Holy Cross School is accredited by the State of Nebraska and also meets archdiocesan educational standards that exceed state and national requirements. Our students consistently perform in the top 25 percent of the nation for core subjects like math, language arts, reading, social studies and science.



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Curriculum

Holy Cross School is accredited by the State of Nebraska and uses the Omaha Archdiocesan Standards-based curriculum to drive and focus our instruction. Our academic curriculum includes religion, reading, language arts, handwriting, phonics, spelling, math, social studies and science. Additionally, we offer Spanish, music, physical education, technology, art and library. Our dedicated staff of teachers has an average of more than 17 years teaching experience, with many holding advanced degrees.

Religion is integrated throughout our entire curriculum. Students participate in weekly Mass and eighth grade students are trained as Liturgy leaders. These leaders help the younger students prepare class Masses.

Discipline with Purpose

The Discipline with Purpose (DWP) program is designed to help students of all ages evolve into compassionate young people. DWP aligns with our mission and teaches our students the skills they need to be self-disciplined and successful in any curricular area.

Technology in the Classroom

Holy Cross is a blended learning community, which means we combine traditional classroom instruction with computer-mediated activities. Technology is used to transform and improve the learning process for our students. Blended learning helps us reach and teach students more effectively using 21st-century technology. It provides our educators with an opportunity to collect data to help customize instruction and assessment of students based on individual needs. Our students have access to chrome books, computers, smart boards, and more to help guide the learning process.

Extracurricular Activities

The learning environment is further enhanced by a variety of activities including a walking club, math competitions, Bible Bowl, Reader's Quiz Bowl, Maker's Space, speech, book clubs, Academic Booster Club, musicals, plays, choir, art club, and a variety of interscholastic sports including basketball, baseball, softball, volleyball, track and soccer.
