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Curriculum

Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School follows a standards-based curriculum prepared by the Archdiocese of Omaha that provides clear expectations for education standards. Our core curriculum includes religion, reading, language arts, mathematics, social studies, and science, as well as specials including art, computer science, health, music, library and technology, physical education, Title I reading and mathematics and ELL/ESL reading intervention programs.

Extracurricular Activities

The learning environment is further enhanced by a variety of activities including dance team, student council, Music in Catholic Schools and more. We also offer baseball, softball, volleyball and basketball for Sts. Peter and Paul students.

Technology in the Classroom

Sts. Peter and Paul is a blended learning community, which means we combine traditional classroom instruction with computer-mediated activities. Technology is used to transform and improve the learning process for our students. Blended learning helps us reach and teach students more effectively using 21st-century technology. It provides our educators with an opportunity to collect data to help customize instruction and assessment of students based on individual needs. Each classroom is equipped with high-definition projectors with Apple-TVs. Our students have access to Chrome Books and a state of the art media center with Apple MacBook laptops and iPads to help guide the learning process.
